What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are used to store small pieces of information. The cookies are stored on your device when the website is loaded on your browser. These cookies help us to make the website function properly, make the website more secure, provide better user experience, and understand how the website performs and analyse what is working correctly and where needs improvement.

How do we use cookies?

As most of the online services, our website uses cookies first-party and third-party cookies for a number of purposes. The first-party cookies are necessary for the website to function the right way, and they do not collect any of your personally identifiable data.

The third-party cookies used on our websites are used mainly for understanding how the website performs, how you interact with our website, keeping our services secure, providing advertisements that are relevant to you, and all in all providing you with a better and improved user experience by speeding up your future interactions with our website.

What types of cookies do we use?

We group the cookies we use on our website into the following categories:

Necessary cookies

These cookies are necessary to enable the basic features of this site to function. The cookies do not collect or store any personal data.

Analytic cookies

These cookies allow us to analyse your use of the site to evaluate and improve our performance. They may also use them to provide a better customer experience on this site.

Description

Google Analytics installs this cookie. The cookie calculates visitor, session, campaign data and keep track of site usage for the site's analytics report. The cookies store information anonymously and assign a random number to identify unique visitors.

Google uses this cookie to distinguish users.

Another cookie Google Analytics installs. The cookie stores information on how visitors use a website and helps in creating an analytics report of how the website is doing. The data it collects includes the number visitors, the source where they have come from, and the pages they visit in an anonymous form.

How can I control my cookie preferences?

You can manage your cookies preferences by clicking on the "Cookie Settings" icon button (bottom left) and enabling or disabling the cookie categories on the popup according to your preferences.

Should you decide to change your preferences later through your browsing session, you can click on the "Cookie Settings" icon button (bottom left). This will display the consent notice again enabling you to change your preferences or withdraw your consent entirely.
